#### **PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Valedictorians = \$7,500 over 4 years Salutatorians = \$5,500 over 4 years

#### **HOME SCHOOL ATTENDEE AWARD**

- 1. See Recruitment Scholarships if home school curriculum taken was from an accredited program recognized by the state in which the program emanates.
- 2. See General Education Diploma (GED) if home school curriculum is from an unaccredited program.

Renewal is contingent upon student maintaining a 2.50 GPA and full-time student status. The number of renewable years will be prorated based on the admission classification of transferable hours. The scholarship is limited to four consecutive academic years. Students must acquire a minimum of 30 hours at the end of each spring semester.
