

UNDERGRADUATE TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Oakwood University will rebate up to 100% of tuition to students who transfer after completing a minimum of 18 credits at another accredited two-year or 4-year college or university + additional scholarships based on academic performance as noted in table below:

DISCLAIMERS

- Annual renewal is contingent upon** student maintaining a 2.00 GPA and earning an average of 15 credit hours per semester. The number of renewable years will be prorated based on the admission classification of transferable hours. The scholarship is limited to four consecutive academic years. Students must acquire a minimum of 30 hours at the end of each spring semester
- All credits earned during the 1st semester free are non-transferable unless student pay entire cost of first semester
- Students must enroll in 2nd semester and attend class until the last day to withdraw to receive the 1st semester free
- All transfer scholarships are nonrefundable.
- The transfer scholarships will be awarded on a per semester basis and once awarded will not be reversed if eligible scholarships are added.
- If a student is awarded and receives any of the ineligible criteria, the transfer scholarships will be reversed.
- Reside on campus (Oakwood University residential facility) and purchase a meal plan (unless exception is granted by Vice President for Student Services)

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS MUST:

- Must transfer at least 18 credit hours from an accredited four-year or two-year college/post-secondary technical school
- Be a eligible to apply for United State Federal Student Financial Aid
- Complete the FAFSA and submit any outstanding documentation (except FAFSA ineligible students)
- Be registered for at least 15 credit hours each semester
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as outlined in the most recent bulletin
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0
- *Participation in the Transfer Scholarship Program may result in the ineligibility for other Oakwood University aid as well as state/federal grants, as listed below**
