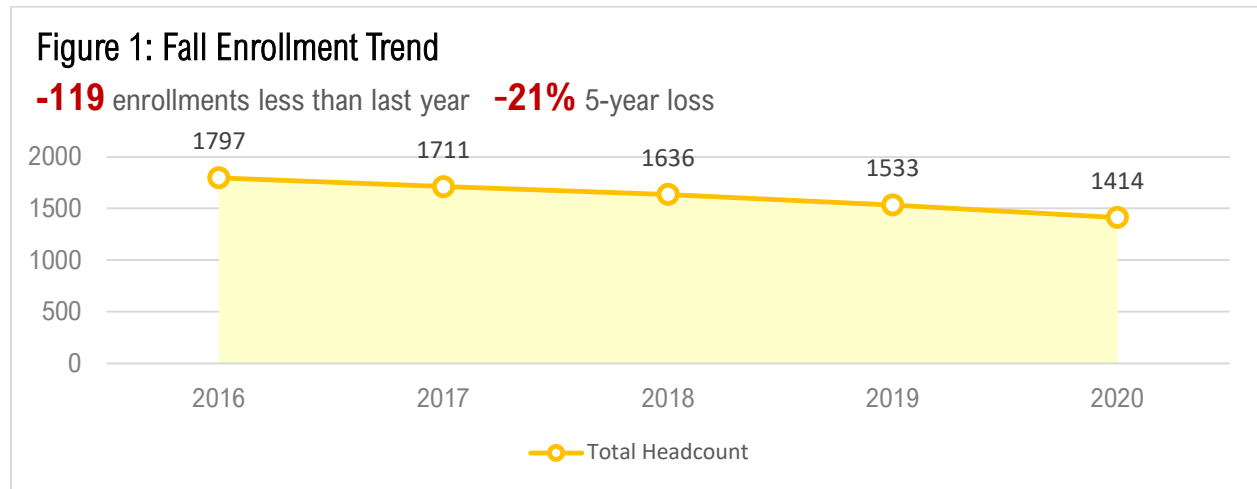

PERCENT CHANGE IN ENROLLMENT OVER 5-YEAR PERIOD

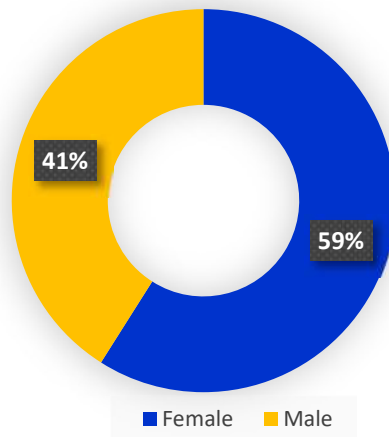

Figure 2: OU Male Female Ratio

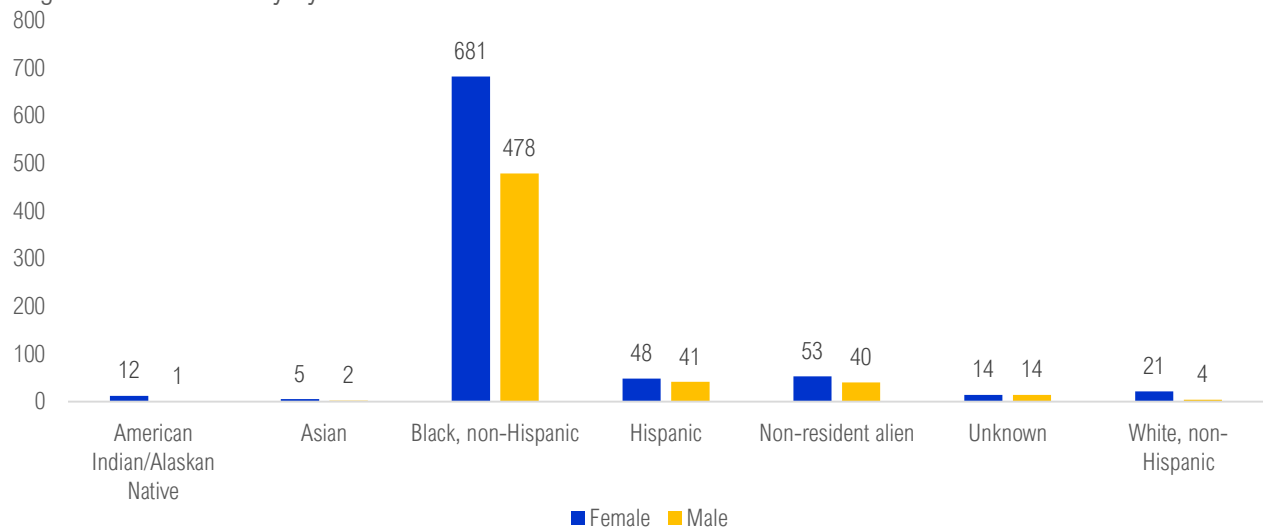

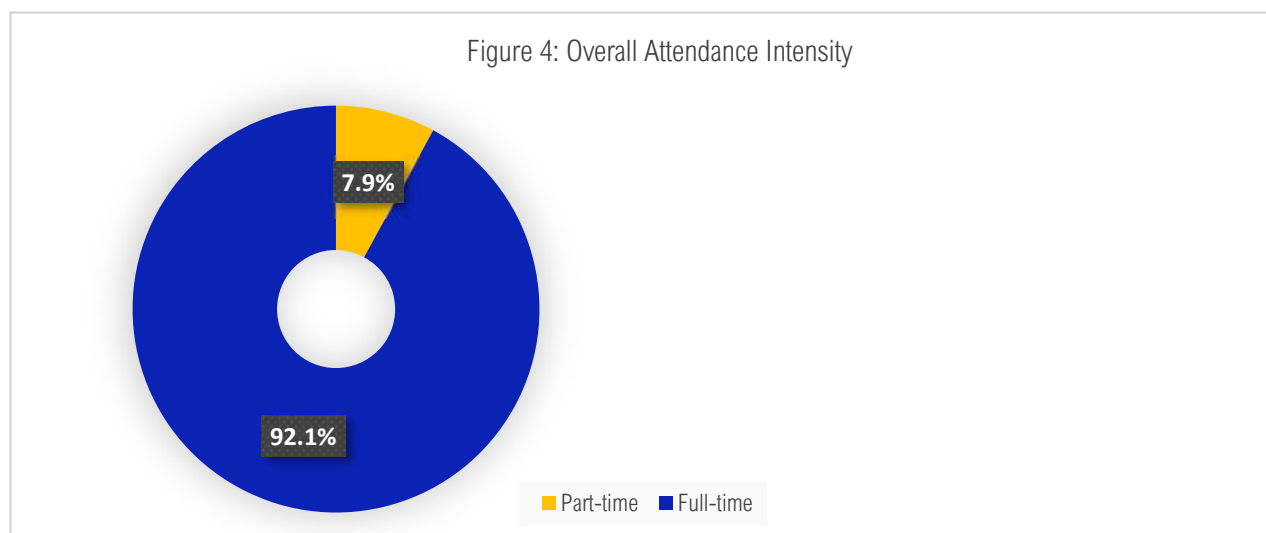

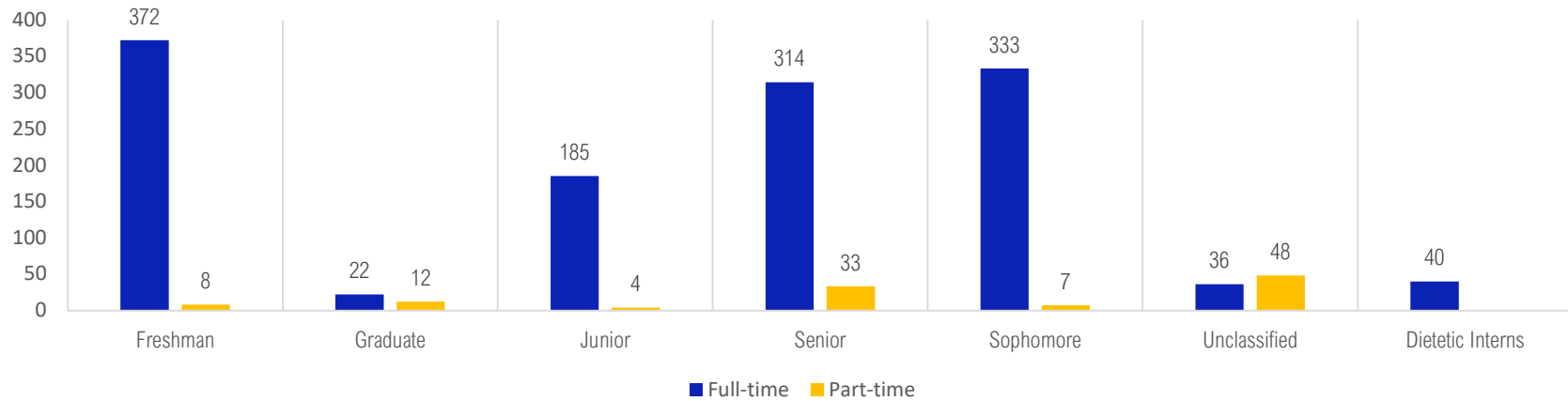

Figure 5: Attendance Intensity by Classification



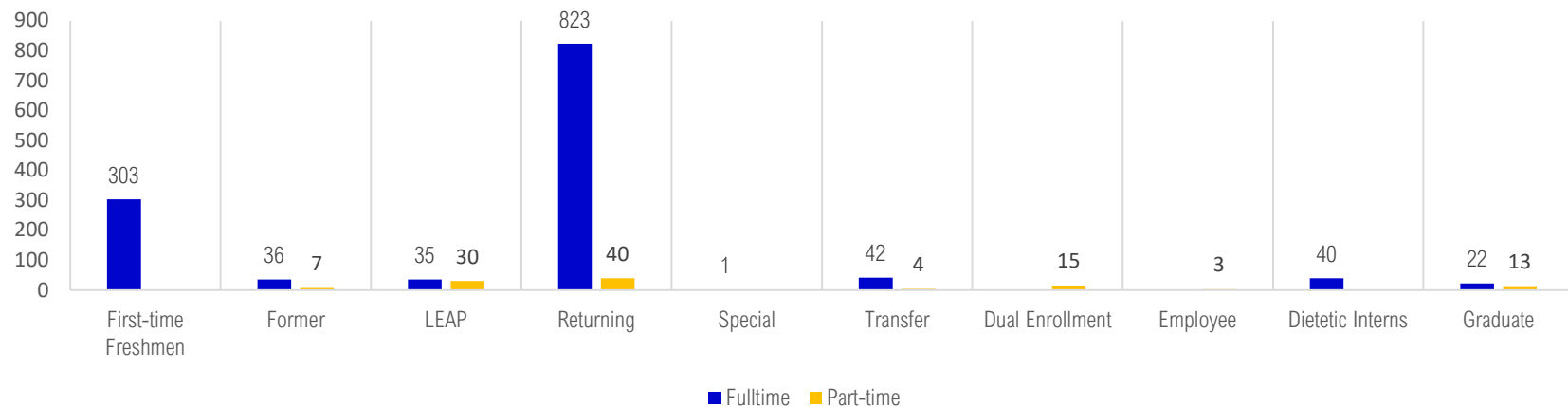

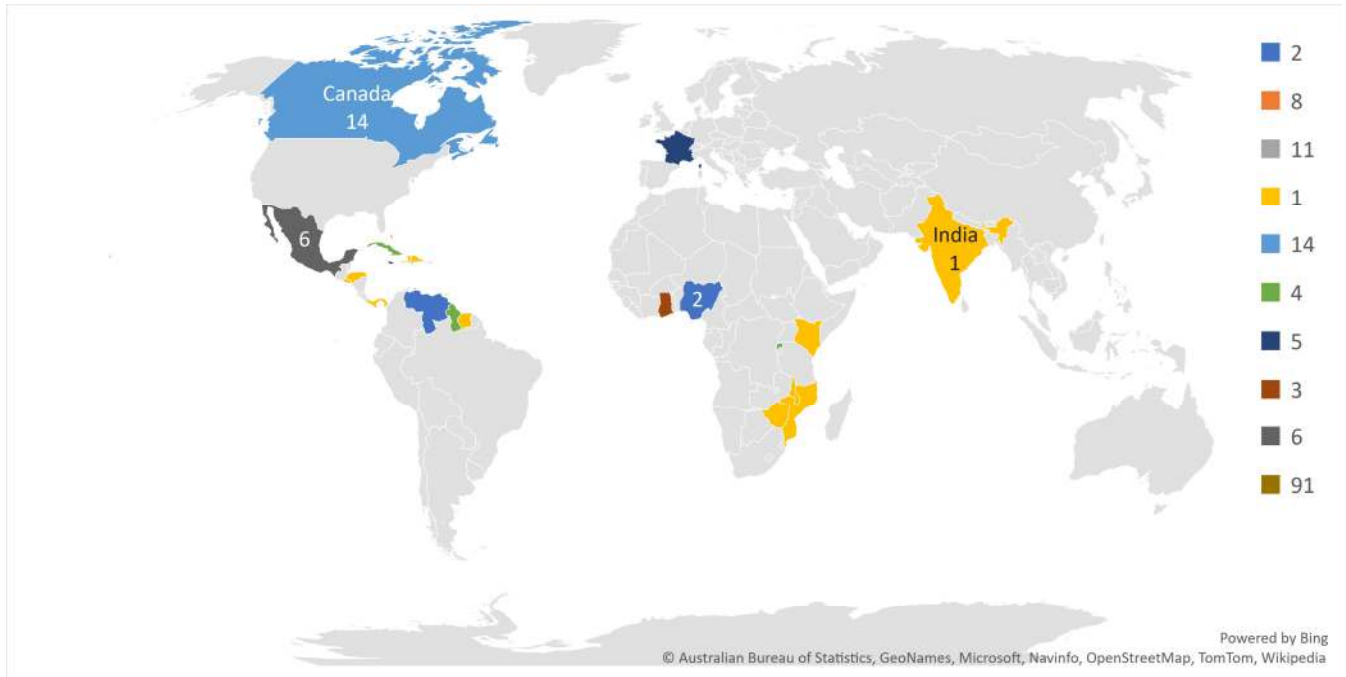

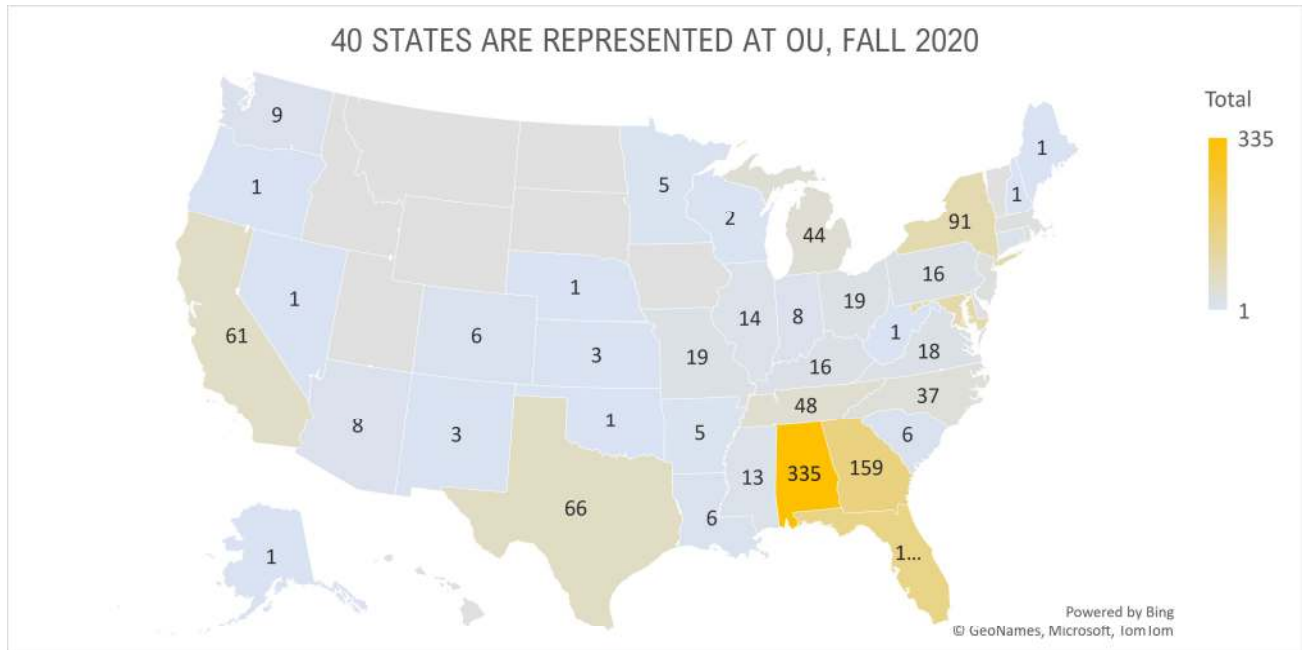
