

Oakwood University My Road to Graduation Scholarship

Oakwood University will provide up to \$3,000 annually (\$1,500 per semester, awarded at the end of the semester) to assist student who enter Oakwood as first-time freshmen and who complete and receive credit for at least 15 earned Oakwood University hours each semester and maintain a 2.0 GPA. Students can receive the scholarship for a maximum of nine semesters.

To be eligible, students must:

- Reside on campus (Oakwood University residential facility) and purchase a meal plan.
- Complete the FAFSA and submit any outstanding documentation (except FAFSA ineligible students)
- Be registered for at least 15 credit hours each semester
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as outlined in the most recent bulletin
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0

Participation in the My Road to Graduation Scholarship may result in the ineligibility for other Oakwood University aid as well as state/federal grants, as listed below
