

Oakwood University COVID-19 Update

August 16, 2020 | Oakwood University has confirmed its first positive COVID-19 case. Upon confirmation of the case, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations and protocols were immediately implemented. Contact tracing was conducted by OU Health Services and all exposed individuals have been quarantined.

Oakwood University remains committed to the health and safety of our campus family. If any future cases are discovered, Oakwood University will continue to follow the recommendations and guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Alabama Department of Public Health for limiting the spread of COVID-19. The University is taking all precautions and following the Health protocols flow chart as written on page 29 in the Oakwood University Reopening Plan. We urge all interested parties to review the Reopening Plan for more information.

Under the commitment to follow the CDC guidelines and the procurement of health and sanitization products, Oakwood University opened on August 1st. However, we continue to solicit your prayers, as we and other institutions of higher education learn to navigate our new normal.
