Dear Oakwood Students,

Oakwood University is a caring community that remains committed to the academic success of every student at Oakwood University. The Oakwood academic leadership appreciates the degree of difficulty experienced by students and faculty associated with navigating in the pandemic environment. Because of the unique and unprecedented challenges associated with COVID-19, the Academic Operations Division which includes the Office of the Provost, the Deans, Chairs, and the Full-time Faculty, have reviewed academic policies and have approved the following temporary, interim policies and processes for fall 2020:

1. Department specific grading accommodations are being implemented for all fall 2020 classes. Your instructors and department chairs will communicate these accommodations directly to you, as appropriate.
2. There will be a non-instructional make-up assignment day on Wednesday, November 11, 2020. No classes will be held on this day.
3. Extra credit will be granted for those students who posted to the Biblical Foundations discussions, as well as the opportunity to post and receive credit for those students who did not.
4. Additional information on tele-health and tele-counseling options will be provided to all students.
5. The withdrawal date for fall 2020 has been extended to November 19. Students who have withdrawn from classes within the last two weeks may reverse their withdrawal decision. Students will need to notify the Registrar's office in writing, as well as their instructors.
6. For students who request an incomplete for fall 2020, the last day for instructors to submit incomplete grades for fall 2020 has been extended to May 3, 2021.
