- Qualifying for federal financial aid (completing FAFSA).
- Possess an unmet financial need.
- A minimum GPA of 2.0+ or an approved Academic Student Engagement plan (ASE) with the Center for Student Success (CSS).†
- Enrolled for at least 15 credit hours each semester.
- Occupancy in an Oakwood University Residence Hall while matriculating.
- Committed to working to defray educational expenses.
- Community minded.
- Dedicated to continuous development.
